Other important areas are electrical engineering, chemistry, plastics, footwear, textiles, etc.



preparation of study visits for representatives of Slovak authorities in coal-fired regions in transition or after their transition in other Member States (France / Belgium, Germany / Greece)



preparation of scenario and schemes for rehabilitation of coal mines and environmental impacts and landscape rehabilitation



support for the development visions of transformation and economic diversification of the region, to identify economic sectors that might arise as a substitute for coal mining.
